



1. What is USSSA Volleyball?

The purpose of USSSA Volleyball is to organize and promote youth and adult volleyball to perpetuate the interest and love of the game. USSSA Volleyball provides an opportunity for teams to compete in league and tournament play, with events at the state, national and world levels.

The USSSA (United States Specialty Sports Association) is an affiliate member of USAV. **Therefore, it is permissible for USAV registered teams to participate in USSSA/MYAS volleyball events without consequence of any USAV sanctions.**

2. How do I register my team?

Team registration is very simple. Go to www.ussa.com and click on 'volleyball'. Then click on 'create user ID' and the system will walk you through the steps. Team registration is only \$25! You will list your athletes and can add or delete players at any time – there are no individual membership fees!

3. How can my team benefit from being sanctioned with USSSA?

By using your registration number (you will be given your registration number when you register your team online) you can set up your own team website. Here you will be able to manage your roster, manage team stats, add photos and keep an awards history for your team. In addition, as we continue to build our volleyball program there will be power rankings and "USSSA Points" assigned to your team based on the results of USSSA events.

4. Does USSSA offer team insurance?

Teams can be sanctioned and insured through USSSA for less than \$125. For club directors or organizations that are purchasing insurance for six or more teams, the cost is even less.
